

PIGSQUEAK BERGENIA CORDIFOLIA

VERY HANDY IN THE SHADE, PIGSQUEAK, OR HEARTLEAF BERGENIA, IS A SLOWLY SPREADING GROUND COVERTHAT FORMS LARGE, SUCCULENT LEAVES AND LATE-WINTERTIME PINK BLOSSOMS. ONCE USED UBIQUITOUSLY IN LANDSCAPES AS A FOUNDATION PLANTING ON THE NORTH SIDE OF THE HOUSE ITS COMMON USAGE HAS FALLEN AWAY SOMEWHAT, BUT NOT FORTHE LACK OF REDEEMING QUALTITES. EVERGREEN AND WITH PALE PINK, POLLINATOR SUSTAINING FLOWERS ON DARK STEMS THAT RISE ABOVE THE CABBAGE-LIKE FOLIAGE, IT IS BOTH DEER RESISTANT AND DROUGHT TOLERANT ONCE ESTABLISHED. THE PLUMP, SHINY (SOME SAY SQUEAKY!) FOLIAGE OFTENTURNS TO SHADES OF PURPLETO BURGUNDY FORTHE COOLER MONTHS, ADDING FURTHER INTEREST TO THOSE COLORLESS WINTER GARDENS. EASILY GROWN.
