OUR BELOVED NATIVE REDBUD, WESTERN REDBUD IS ONE TOUGH CUSTOMER OFTEN FOUND IN CANYONS, SOMETIMES GROWING ON PRECARIOUSLY STEEP SLOPES IN POOR, ROCKY SOIL, IT NEVER FAILS TO DELIGHT WHEN IT'S DEEP PINK BLOSSOMS APPEAR ON THE BARE BRANCHES IN EARLY SPRING, DRAWING BUTTERFLIES FROM MILES AROUND. AT 10-18' TALL AT MATURITY, WESTERN REDBUD IS EITHER A SMALL TREE OR A LARGE SHRUB. EITHER WAY, ITS BEAUTIFUL FLOWERS, NICE ROUNDED FOLIAGE, SILVERY BARK, PURPLISH SEED PODS, AND YELLOW TO PINK FALL COLOR ARE A DELIGHT.
