WITH SMALL WHITE AND RED BLOSSOMS THAT LOOKLIKE LITTLE PINWHEELS, THIS SMALL GROWING ROCKROSE SEEMS TO ANNOUNCE THE COMING OF FESTIVE SUMMER FUN! BLOOMING IN LATE SPRING, THE SOFT, TRAILING MOUND OF DARK GREEN LEAVES BECOMES THOROUGHLY DOTTED WITH 1 1/2" BLOOMS THAT CONTINUE OPENING FOR ABOUT A MONTH. AN EVERGREEN SHRUB, IT REACHES 1 1/2-2 HIGH AND 3-4 ACROSS AND IS GREATFOR COVERING SLOPES. DROUGHT AND HEAT TOLERANT AS THE ROCK ROSES ARE, IT WILL NEED LITTLE FROM YOU ONCE ESTABLISHED. WITH THEIR PRETTY, CREPE PAPER BLOSSOMS, ROCK ROSES LOOK FAR MORE DELICATE THAN THEY ARE, BUT THESE ARE A GROUP OF SUPERTOUGH, MEDITERRANEAN SHRUBS.
