

# MRS. BRADSHAW AVENS

## GEUM CHILOENSE 'DOUBLE MRS. BRADSHAW'

THIS OLD FASHIONED PERENNIAL HAS YEARS OF GARDEN PERFORMANCE UNDER ITS BELT. THE LOW FOLIAGE IS TOPPED IN EARLY SUMMER BY MASSES OF DELICATE SEMI-DOUBLE FLOWERS PERCHED ON LONG, 2 1/2' TALL SLENDER STALKS, WITH FLOWERS CONTINUING TO APPEAR THROUGH THE SUMMER TO ENCOURAGE REPEAT BLOOMING, EACH STALK MAY BE CUT TO THE GROUND ONCE THE FLOWERS HAVE FADED. A RARE BURST OF COLOR FOR SEMI-SHADED AREAS, MRS. BRADSHAW ATTRACTS POLLINATORS AND MINGLES BEAUTIFULLY WITH OTHER BLOOMS IN THE SHADE, LIKE PERENNIAL FOXGLOVES AND CORAL BELLS.
