HEUCHERA x BRIZOIDES 'BRESSINGHAM HYBRIDS' - CORAL

IN RECENT YEARS, THE BRILLIANT CERISE BLOSSOMS OF CORAL BELLS HAVE BEEN SACRIFICED BY BREEDERS FOR THE SAKE OF COLORFUL LEAVES. NOT SO WITH THE BRESSINGHAM HYBRIDS. ALL THE FLORAL SPLENDOR OF YESTERYEAR'S CORAL BELLS IS RETAINED IN THIS OFFSPRING OF CALIFORNIA NATIVE H. SANGUINEA. THE HUMMINGBIRDS WILL THANK YOU AS PLANTS SHOOT UP GLOWING CORAL FLOWER SPIKES REPEATEDLY THROUGH SPRING AND INTO MID-SUMMER. GREAT FOR ADDING COLOR TO AREAS WITH FILTERED SHADE, IT IS BOTH DEER RESISTANT AND DROUGHT-TOLERANT AND PERFECT FOR PLANTING IN THE SHADE OF OAK TREES, WHERE IT WILL MULTIPLY TO FORM A SMALL SCALE GROUND COVER. BECAUSE THESE ARE SEED GROWN, THERE WILL BE SOME VARIABILITY IN FLOWER COLOR, BUT ALL ARE DELIGHTFUL.
