NATIVE FLOWERS SUPREME! SEVERAL CALIFORNIA NATIVE IRISES HAVE GIVEN RISE TO THE VERY NICE PACIFIC COAST HYBRIDS. CANYON SNOW IS ONE OF THE BEST AND EASIEST TO GROW OF THEM. IN SPRING, THE EVERGREEN GRASSY CLUMPS SEND UP MULTIPLE STEMS BEARING LOVELY WHITE BLOSSOMS, EACH WITH A TOUCH OF YELLOW, WHICH BECOME MORE AND MORE NUMEROUS WITH EACH PASSING YEAR. PLANT IN PARTIAL SHADE, GIVE THEM OCCASIONAL SPRINKLING WATER DURING THE DRY MONTHS, AND PROVIDE THEM WITH REASONABLY DRAINING, SLIGHTLY ACIDIC, ORGANIC SOIL. THESE DEER RESISTANT BEAUTIES ARE READY TO GRACE YOUR GARDEN FOR YEARS TO COME! FANTASTIC UNDER NATIVE OAKS WHERE THE FILTERED LIGHT AND DRY-ISH CONDITIONS SUIT THEM QUITE WELL.
