WHERE HAVE ALL THE KNAUTIAS GONE? NOT OFTEN SEEN ANYMORE, THIS DROUGHT AND HEAT TOLERANT PERENNIAL IS RED'S ANSWER TO SCABIOSA. ATTRACTIVE TO BUTTERFLIES AND BEES, THE SEED HEADS, ATTRACTIVE IN THEIR OWN RIGHT, ARE ALSO ENJOYED BY BIRDS. 1 1/2-3 FEET TALL AND WIDE IN BLOOM, THE REDDISH PURPLE DOME-TOPPED BUTTON BLOOMS SIT UPON WIRY STEMS, APPEAR OVER A LONG SEASON IN SUMMER, AND ARE GOOD FOR CUT FLOWERS. TRY WITH ORNAMENTAL GRASSES FOR A STUNNING DISPLAY. GREAT OLD-FASHIONED PERENNIAL FOR WILDFLOWER AND COTTAGE GARDENS
