TRULY A SMALL SHRUB, STICKY MONKEY FLOWER IS EVERGREEN AND BLOOMS OVER A LONG PERIOD FROM SPRING INTO SUMMER, AND OFTEN AGAIN IN FALL. HIGHLY DROUGHT AND HEAT-TOLERANT (THOUGH TENDING TO GO SUMMER DORMANT WITH NO WATER AT ALL), IT'S A SHOO-IN FOR THE NATIVE GARDEN. STICKY MONKEY FLOWER WILL DELIGHT HUMMINGBIRDS THAT SIP HAPPILY FROM ITS TUBULAR BLOOMS THAT SOME SAY RESEMBLE A MONKEY'S FACE. STUNNING IN BLOOM!
