## PACIFIC WAX MYRILE MORELLA (AKA MYRICA) CALIFORNICA

IF YOU NEED AN EVERGREEN NATIVE SHRUBTHAT GROWS FAST, AND DOESN'T NEED A WHOLE LOT OF WATER OR NICE SOIL TO DO IT, PACIFIC WAX MYRTLE MAY BE JUST THE THING. REACHING 10-20 TALL AND WIDE, IT CAN BE SHEARED AS A HEDGE, GROWN AS ATREE FORM, OR LEFT ALONE TO GROW WITH THE DENSE, BUSHY HABIT NATURE GAVE IT. UNLIKE MANY NATIVE PLANTS VALUED FORTHEIR DROUGHT TOLERANCE, PACIFIC WAX MYRTLE ALSO DOES WELL IN SEASONALLY WET SITES, AND PRETTY MUCH EVERYTHING IN BETWEEN. WHILE THE BLOOMS ARE NOTHING TO WRITE HOME ABOUT, THE PLANTITSELF IS A NTTROGEN FIXER AND SO IS ABLETO GROW ON POOR SOIL WHILE IMPROVING THE SOIL FOR OTHER PLANTS. A LARVAL FOOD SOURCE FOR SEVERAL BUTTERFLY SPECIES, IT ALSO PROVIDES HABITAT AND FOOD FOR BIRDS.
