THIS PARTICULAR ONE IS A BIT DIFFERENT, THOUGH, IN THAT IS STAYS MORE COMPACT. REACHING ONLY ABOUT 18"TALL BY 2-21/2 ACROSS, IT MAKES A NICE FOREGROUND PLANT. STRONGLY MINTY-SCENTED, IT DEFIES DEER TO EAT IT, WHICH THEY HAVE NEVER YET FOR US. BEES ADORE THE ABUNDANT BLOOMS AND NO GARDEN HOPING TO FEED THE BEES SHOULD BE WITHOUT IT. DROUGHT TOLERANT AND TOUGH, IT CAN BE CUT BACK AFTER BLOOM TO GROW OUT AND WILL OFTEN BLOOM AGAIN. A FRAGRANT ADDITION TO HERB GARDENS, ROCK GARDENS, OR JUST ABOUT ANYWHERE, IT ALSO MAKES A GOOD CONTAINER SUBJECT. VERY NICE!
