BRASSICA NAPUS RED RUSSIAN THE MOSTTENDER OF ALL THE KALES, OAK LEAF TYPES LIKE RED RUSSIAN ARE DELICIOUS EATEN FRESH. COMING FROM SIBERIA, RED RUSSIAN IS EXTREMELY COLD HARDY, TOLERATING TEMPERATURES TO -10°, AND BECOMES SWEETER, MORE TENDER, AND MORE RICHLY COLORED AFTER A FROST. INVALUABLE IN THE COOL-SEASON GARDEN, WHERE IT WILL GROWTHROUGH THE WINTER HARVEST BABY GREENS FOR SALADS AND LARGER LEAVES FOR BRAISING, ADDING TO SOUPS, AND FOR A LOVELY WINTER GARNISH. TIP: DIPPING THE LEAVES IN COLD WATER EXTENDS THE STORAGE LIFE OF THIS DELICATE KALE.
