

# WOODS' WILD ROSE

ZONES 3-8

THICKETING THEIR THORNY CANES THROUGH WOODLANDS AND OPEN AREAS WHERE MOISTURE IS FOUND, WILD ROSES IN FULL BLOOM ARE A SIGHT TO BEHOLD. REACHING AS MUCH AS 6' IN HEIGHT, THOUGH MORE COMMONLY 3', WOOD'S WILD ROSE BECOMES HEAVY WITH 2-3" SWEETLY SCENTED BLOSSOMS IN EARLY SUMMER. A GREAT HABITAT PLANT, OUR NATIVE WILD ROSES PROVIDE A SHELTERED HOME FOR BIRDS OF MANY KINDS, WHILE THE BLOOMS SUPPLY NECTAR FOR POLLINATORS. THE RED HIPS THAT FOLLOW THE BLOSSOMS PROVIDE FOOD FOR MANY A CREATURE DURING THE WINTER MONTHS WHEN FOOD CAN BECOME SCARCE. DROUGHT-TOLERANT ONCE ESTABLISHED, IT IS A TOUGH PLANT AND EASY TO GROW, TOLERATING MANY SOIL TYPES. SPREADS WHERE HAPPY, SO GIVE IT ROOM TO GROW!
