CUTE AS A BUTTON, ROSULARIA FORMS A CREEPING MAT OF TINY HENS AND CHICKS-LIKE SUCCULENT ROSETTES. THE CHICKS APPEAR IN THE FORM OF TINY BALLS ON PINKISH STRINGS AND WILL ROOT WHEREVER THEY TOUCH SOIL. THE WHITE FLOWERS APPEAR IN SPRING AND REMIND US OF STRAWBERRY FLOWERS. COMPLETELY HARDY TO FROST, YOU CAN TUCK THIS ONE IN ALL

SORTS OF SEEMINGLY UNINHABITABLE PLACES, SUCH AS CREVICES IN ROCKS, BUT DO BE SURE IT HAS GOOD DRAINAGE. APPRECIATES PARTIAL SHADE IN HOT SUMMER CLIMATES LIKE OURS.
