ACCUSTOMED TO SHARING ITS HOME WITH TALL PRAIRIE GRASSES, IT HAS A TENDENCY TO LEAN ON ITS NEIGHBORS FOR SUPPORT, BUTCAN BE KEPT MORE COMPACT BY PINCHING 2 OR 3 TIMES DURING THE GROWING SEASON. DEEP ROOTED AND DROUGHT TOLERANT, IT ALSO HOLDS UP TO HUNGRY DEER PRAIRIE SAGE
