

PINK AUTUMN SAGE

SALVIA GREGGII 'PINK'



FOR DEER RESISTANCE ON A BLOOMING PLANT, IT IS HARD TO BEAT THE AUTUMN SAGES. THOUSANDS OF SMALL SALVIA FLOWERS THAT REMIND US OF TINY, SWIRLING, FLAMENCO SKIRTS APPEAR ON THIS VARIETY OVER A LONG BLOOM SEASON. DEEP, RICH PINK WITH A DARK CALYX, THEY, LIKE ALL THE SALVIAS, ATTRACT POLLINATORS IN DROVES, WHILE DELIGHTING US WITH BLOOMS ON LONG, SLENDER STALKS THAT CAN APPEAR ALL SEASON, BUT ARE MOST PROLIFIC FROM MIDSUMMER ON. THE AROMATIC FOLIAGE IS A NICE, DEEP GREEN THAT PROVIDES A GREAT FOIL FOR THE SASSY, SATURATED BLOSSOMS. FORMS A NEAT 2X3' MOUND AND IS EASY TO FIND ROOM FOR IN THE GARDEN. CUT THE AUTUMN SAGES BACK IN SPRING TO REJUVENATE. DROUGHT TOLERANT.
