

RED STONECROP

SEDUM MORANENSE

HERE'S A TOUGH LITTLE GROUND COVER SUCCULENT THAT FILLS SPACES AS IT GROWS. STAYING UNDER 4" IN HEIGHT, ITS TIGHTLY PACKED STEMS MAKE A DENSE, QUICK GROWING COVER FOR BARE SPOTS. FROM THE MOUNTAINS OF MEXICO, RED STONECROP IS FULLY FROST HARDY, BUT ALSO TOLERATES THE HEAT OF SUMMER. ITS SUPERB DROUGHT-TOLERANCE, DENSE EVERGREEN FOLIAGE, AND FAST GROWTH MAKE IT A WIDESPREAD CHOICE FOR GREEN ROOFS. ITS STARRY WHITE BLOSSOMS ARE ATTRACTIVE TO BUTTERFLIES. AND AS FOR THE NAME "RED" STONECROP? LIKE MANY OF ITS KIN, IT HAS A TENDENCY TO TURN A BRONZY, REDDISH COLOR IN COOL WINTER TEMPERATURES. NICE LITTLE PLANT.
