

SIERRA STONECROP



SEDUM OBTUSATUM

THIS PRETTY LITTLE EVERGREEN CALIFORNIA NATIVE STONECROP OCCURS AT HIGH ELEVATIONS IN THE SIERRAS WHERE IT GROWS IN SOME OF THE MOST UNWELCOMING PLACES. NO STRANGER TO THE COLD, IT SHRUGS OFF WINTER EFFORTLESSLY, DURING WHICH ITS SUCCULENT STEMS TURN A BRIGHT, FESTIVE RED. A MAT-FORMER, IT REACHES ONLY ABOUT 6" HIGH, TRAILING AND ROOTING

AS IT GOES. ITS UNUSUAL BLOSSOMS EMERGE YELLOW AND FADE TO PINK AND ARE QUITE PRETTY. DROUGHT TOLERANT AS SUCCULENTS ARE, BE SURE TO PROVIDE IT WITH QUICK DRAINING SOIL (THINK GRAVELLY!)
