

YELLOW GERMANDER

TEUCRIUM FLAVUM



ZONES 7-9

THIS SMALL SHRUBBY GERMANDER HAS NICE EVERGREEN FOLIAGE AND MIDSUMMER, POLLINATOR ATTRACTING BLOOMS IN WHITE TO THE PALEST, CREAMY YELLOW. WE FIND IT USEFUL AS A DEER RESISTANT, DROUGHT-TOLERANT PLANT FOR LIGHTLY SHADED AREAS, WHERE IT GROWS NEARLY AS A GROUND COVER AT UNDER 12" TALL BY 2-3 FEET WIDE. A NATIVE OF ROCKY, DRY SITES IN THE MEDITERRANEAN, YELLOW GERMANDER IS QUITE USED TO THE IDEA OF DROUGHTY SUMMERS AND LONG, WET WINTERS. THRIVES IN POOR, WELL-DRAINED SOIL. PLANT A FOOT APART FOR GROUND COVER AND SHEAR BACK A COUPLE OF TIMES DURING THE GROWING SEASON TO KEEP IT NICE AND BUSHY, PARTICULARLY AFTER BLOOM. USED MEDICINALLY.
