THIS LITTLE-BITTY PLANT PACKS A LEMON SCENTED PUNCH!
THE LEMON IN THE THYME IS NOT JUST THE LOVELY YELLOW
VARIEGATION ON ITS TINY LEAVES. THE AROMATIC LEAVES ARE
GREAT USED FOR SEASONING WHERE THE PERKY LEMON
FLAVOR ADDS AN UNEXPECTED TWIST (PUN INTENDED). ITS
SMALL, PALE PINK BLOSSOMS ARE A GREAT POLLINATOR
ATTRACTOR AND THE 6-8" TALL PLANT ITSELF IS EVERGREEN
AND TRAILING, MAKING IT NICE FOR EDGING AND THE FRONT OF
YOUR EDIBLE BORDER. DROUGHT-TOLERANT, DEER RESISTANT,
AND NOT AT ALL FUSSY ABOUT POOR SOIL; DO PUT THIS ONE
WHERE YOU CAN REGULARLY BRUSH AGAINST IT TO RELEASE
ITS LEMONY FRESH SCENT.
